Gil A. Miller, the Court-appointed receiver in this matter (the "Receiver"), filed his Motion to Approve Third Distribution (CM/ECF No. 2894) ("Distribution Motion"). Falconhead Property Owners Association, Inc. (the "FPOA") filed an Objection to Receiver's Motion to Approve Third Distribution (CM/ECF No. 2913), arguing that the reserve pending the outcome of the dispute between the Receiver and the FPOA regarding the FPOA's claim should be \$1,647,873.50. The Receiver filed a Supplement to Receiver's Motion to Approve Third Distribution (CM/ECF No. 2921), wherein the Receiver agreed to reserve the \$1,647,873.50

pending the resolution of the dispute regarding the FPOA's claim thereby resolving the FPOA's objection.

The Court conducted a hearing on the Third Distribution Motion on November 18, 2015, at 1:30 p.m. The Receiver and his counsel, Doyle S. Byers, appeared. Daniel J. Wadley appeared on behalf of the Securities and Exchange Commission. No one appeared on behalf of the FPOA. No other objections were raised at the hearing.

Subsequent to the hearing, the Receiver's counsel provided information and materials to the Court regarding the interpleading of distributions to the Clerk of the Court for certain distributions for claims made by Diane A. Thompson (the court-appointed receiver for American Pension Services, Inc.) to be further disbursed by Judge Robert Shelby in the case of *Securities and Exchange Commission v. American Pension Services, Inc., et al.*, Case No. 2:14-cv-00309.


Having considered the Third Distribution Motion, the filings of the parties, arguments of counsel, the information and materials provided to the Court following the hearing, and good cause appearing, the Court HEREBY FINDS and ORDERS as follows:

1. The Third Distribution Motion is GRANTED;
2. The Receiver shall distribute \$21,000,000.00 as outlined in the Distribution Motion; and

3. The Receiver shall reserve \$6,276,925.49 pending the resolution of remaining disputes.
